**OPEN SUBMISSIONS POLICY**

Ensemble Studio Theatre-LA accepts submissions of new full-length and one-act plays directly from artists as well as from talent representatives.

To submit a new play for production consideration, please follow the guidelines below.

We accept up to three scripts (total) from any writer during the submission window.

**Submission window:** March 15 - May 31, 2007

**Enclose:** One copy of the script

Character breakdown including age range, gender and other defining characteristics of each character

The play's production history (if any)

Artist's resume or bio

Artist's complete contact information, including name, address, telephone and email

If you would like acknowledgement that your script has been received, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard.

NOTE: Only scripts that have not premiered in Los Angeles will be considered. You will be notified only if your script is selected. We are unable to return scripts.

**FULL-LENGTH PLAYS**
